## Emergency power interruption to Tumby Bay today

Electricity supply to around 400 customers at Tumby Bay will be interrupted between 12noon and 2pm today, in order for crews to replace a pole located on the main highway that was damaged during Saturday's storm.

The only way to replace the pole safely is to switch off electricity to customers supplied by that line. ETSA Utilities expects the work will take no longer than two hours and apologises for any inconvenience caused.
